

# Psalm 72 - God's Purpose with the Earth

## PSALM 72.

<sup>1</sup> David, praying for Solomon, sheweth the goodness and glory of his kingdom in type, and of Christ's in truth. <sup>18</sup> He bleisseth God *A Psalm 7 for Solomon.*

v1-7 Christ's righteous reign brings peace to the whole world

An insight into the character of God and His Son. Here is the goodness and severity of God: **Rom 11:22**

God uses the natural creation to make the Bible interesting. It also helps us to see God's purpose everywhere we go.

v8-11 Christ's dominion to extend through the Earth

**G**IVE the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto <sup>a</sup>the king's son.

v17-20 Praise to God as His glory fills the whole earth

v17 Fulfillment of Abrahamic covenant

Other key verses are:

**Rev 4:11** God created man to give Him pleasure

**Isaiah 45:18** God made the earth to be inhabited, it was for a purpose

**God's Name to be perfectly revealed in His Saints:**

**Zech 14:5,9** The immortal Saints are ONE with Christ and each other

**Rev 14:1** The Saints have God's character imprinted on their minds

**Rev 3:12** What a wonderful promise is offered to those who overcome!

**God had a purpose right from the beginning:**

**Psa 115:14-16** The earth was created for man to inhabit

**Matt 25:34** God always had a purpose for a Kingdom on Earth

**John 17:24-26** Jesus was in God's mind before Creation

**Isa 43:7,21** We are created to reflect God's glory

**Acts 15:14** We are called out of the Gentiles to be a people for God's "Name"

**Eph 1:4** God's plan for an ecclesia was right there from the beginning.

**1 Pet 2:9** God chose us for a reason – to be like Him and to shine as lights

**Key Verses: Psalm 72v17-19:** God's purpose is to fill the earth with his glory. His glory is His character: **Exod 33:18-19.**

**Psalm 72:19** tells us about God's Name and His purpose. This whole chapter shows how God's character will be revealed in the Kingdom.

God's purpose is to have children who are like Him. He wants us to love the things He loves, and hate the things which He hates. These are the people God wants in His Kingdom.

We learn how God thinks through His Word, through which He breathes his ideas: **2 Tim 3:15-17; Prov 3:1-6.** This must be seen in the way we live our lives: **Rom 12:2; 1 Pet 1:23-25.**

Jesus is the only one who was perfectly like God in his life: **John 1:14.** Jesus is therefore called "the glory of the Lord": **Isaiah 40:5.** God's children love Jesus Christ and want to be like him, and are therefore baptised "into" him.

Remember that God's character is explained in **Exod 34:5-7.**

God's Name (Yahweh) reminds us of His Purpose with the Earth. Yahweh means "He who will be". But WHO will God be? God will be seen in people! These people will be MIGHTY ONES. This is why God is sometimes called **Yahweh Elohim: Exod 3:15**, or "He who will be mighty ones".

**Lesson:** God wants us to show His character to others. If we are like God now, He will love to have us in His Kingdom.
